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REPORTING OF STATISTICAL DATA REGARDING AN EMPLOYEE LEASING COMPANY

Senate Bill No. 361 ("SB 361"), effective October 1, 2009, includes provisions relating to statistical reporting of workers' compensation insurance regarding employee leasing companies. Subsection 3 of section 4 of SB 361 requires each insurer that insures leased employees to report certain data to the advisory organization designated by the Commissioner of Insurance ("Commissioner"). Subparagraph 6 of paragraph (b) of subsection 5 of section 4 of SB 361 requires that loss experience of the client company of an employee leasing company be reported to the Commissioner. This Bulletin clarifies the process for reporting statistical information, including loss experience, pursuant to section 4 of SB 361.

Pursuant to NRS 686B.1764, the Commissioner designated the National Council on Compensation Insurance, Inc. ("NCCI") to collect and tabulate statistical information in a Uniform Statistical Plan. NRS 686B.1773 requires every insurer to record and report its experiences and losses for policies of industrial insurance to the advisory organization designated by the Commissioner. Therefore, all statistical reports required by section 4 of SB 361, including loss experience reports, pursuant to subparagraph 6 of paragraph (b) of subsection 5, must be reported to the NCCI.
