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## REGISTERED DOMESTIC PARTNERSHIP OR CIVIL UNION ENDORSEMENT

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Throughout your policy the first paragraph of the definition of **Family Member** is deleted and replaced by:

**Family Member** means a person who is a resident of **your** household and related to **you** by blood, marriage, adoption, registered domestic partnership or civil union as recognized by the state in which this policy was issued. This definition also includes a ward or foster child.

The remainder of the definition is unchanged.

In the **General Provisions** of your policy provision, **9. a. Transfer of Interest in This Policy** is deleted and replaced by:

- a. The surviving spouse, registered domestic partner or civil union partner, if resident in the same household at the time of death. Coverage applies to the spouse, registered domestic partner or civil union partner as recognized by the state in which this policy was issued as if a named insured shown in the Coverage Summary; and

If your coverage summary indicates that you have purchased one or more Motor Vehicle segments, provision **2.** under **Medical Expense - Motor Vehicle, Limit of Liability**, the last paragraph of provision **2.** is deleted and replaced by:

This funeral service expenses benefit does not increase, and will not be paid in addition to, the limits of liability stated on the Coverage Summary for "Medical Expense." This benefit is payable to the deceased injured person's spouse, registered domestic partner or civil union partner as recognized by the state in which this policy was issued, if a resident of the same household at the time of the accident. However, if the deceased is a minor, the benefit is payable to any parent who is a resident of the same household at the time of the accident. In all other cases, the benefit is payable to the deceased injured person's estate.

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
